401	1 <b>Grand Cuvee Moutard Brut NV.0 Champagne</b> Young, lively fruit flavours and a fresh, vivid aroma characterise this attractive Champagne.	£36.00
402	2 <b>Cava Brut Rosé, Spain</b> Soft and luscious with exotic fruit characters and slight sweetness balanced by a crisp finish.	£17.25
403	2 <b>Taltarni Brut Australia</b> Soft and sparkling with a lively effervescence, a perfect combination of fruit and acidity. Approachable and easy-drinking with a good length.	£17.25
404	6 <b>Asti Spumante, Dolce-Araldica Italy</b> The elegant, yet richly fruity bouquet of this superb Asti is matched by a deliciously concentrated flavour on the palate and a stylish grapey acidity on the finish.	£16.25

405	1 <b>Chablis (La Colombe) France</b> A traditional Chablis, dry, flinty and elegant with distinctive Chardonnay character on the finish.	£17.95
406	3 <b>Sauvignon Gris, Cousino Macul Chile</b> Floral with assertive fruitiness, reminiscent of pink grapefruit and mango and with a rich, fleshy texture and bright acidity. It definitely has a personality of its own.	£16.50
409	2 <b>Chenin Blanc South Africa</b> Fresh, zesty wine with a good level of flavour and complexity, derived from a maturation period spent on its lees.	£16.50
410	1 <b>Pinot-Grigio, Conviviale Italy</b> Crisp, dry and with a real 'zing'. Cool-fermented in stainless-steel tanks to ensure maximum retention of freshness as well as aromas and fruit flavours.	£16.50

411	4	<b>Crouchen Riesling, Brown Brothers</b> <b>Australian</b> Aromas of ripe pears, tropical fruit and citrus. A medium sweet wine with the residual sweetness balanced by the crisp acidity of the Riesling grape.	£16.75
413	2	<b>Semillon-Sauvignon-Chardonnay, Marktree</b> <b>Australia</b> Attractive sweet citrus, melon and peach-like fruit characters with a background of subtle nutty oak. Medium-bodied in style, dominated by fresh varietal fruit flavours on a background of lightly toasted oak.	£16.95
415	2	<b>Viognier, North Coast</b> <b>Chile</b> Barrel-fermented in 100% French oak and allowed to rest on the lees for three months. Very creamy texture and with the unmistakable and haunting aroma of dried apricots, which is the hallmark of classic Viognier.	£16.50
417	1	<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, Crowded House</b> <b>New Zealand</b> Herbaceous and flavoursome from this world renowned estate. The palate is lively and intense, with mouth-filling, tropical fruit flavours.	£17.95

412	D	<b>Chateauneuf- Du- Pape</b> <b>France</b> Deep ruby in colour and very full-bodied with a heady,spicey bouquet : ripe fruits and a long velvety finish.	£ 18.95
414	D	<b>Cabernet Sauvignon Waterstone Bridge, Reserve</b> A deep garnet red colour with aromas of vanilla and blackberry. A soft rich fruit palate with hints of spice, soft tannins and a smooth finish	£17.95
418	D	<b>Zinfandel - Syrah</b> <b>USA</b> A powerful, spicy wine with typical black pepper, plum and berry-fruit aromas and flavour. The palate is very full-bodied but with ripe, velvety tannins giving a smooth, rounded finish.	£17.75
419	C	<b>Saint-Emilion, Chateau Mondotte</b> <b>France</b> A blend of mainly Merlot plus some Cabernet Franc, matured for twelve months in bottle. The wine exhibits the Merlot's typical plummy fruit character.	£17.95
420	C	<b>St Clair Pinot Noir</b> <b>New Zealand</b> Rich, vibrant and youthful, a high quality example of this most difficult grape, showing cherry fruit aromas and blueberry flavours, subtly integrated in French oak to leave a soft finish.	£17.75
421	C	<b>Seguret</b> A classic Rhône wine sporting structure and finesse. Intense notes of vanilla, black cherry fruit and spice on the nose, rich morello cherry and chocolate flavours on the palate. A great alternative to Chateauneuf du Pape	£17.25

422	C	<b>Pinotage, South Africa</b> Ripe, complex, with a berry fruit and herb character, typical of this popular South African varietal. The maximum aroma and complexity is achieved by cool fermentation techniques and barrel-ageing.	£16.50
423	C	<b>Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Artesa Spain</b> A rich, full-bodied red made in the traditional way, with at least one year of oak ageing. It has a bright raspberry and cherry fruit character and a silky smooth finish.	£16.95
424	C	<b>Garnacha &amp; Tempranillo, - Ochoa Spain</b> This young wine is a perfect marriage of these two grape varieties. Deep ruby red, intense and fruity raspberries from Tempranillo and cherries from the Garnacha.	£16.50
425	D	<b>Shiraz Reserve, Waterstone Bridge Australia</b> This red wine has set a benchmark for Shiraz, typically robust in character, with deep, rich fruit and a long, warm, spicy finish.	£17.95
426	D	<b>Malbec, Nieto Reserva Argentina</b> A deeply-coloured, powerful red with great concentration of berry fruit. Complex flavours of plums and figs with a smoky vanilla character and good finish.	£16.50
